

- Taking a soil sample, a 4 oz soil jar should be packed as full as possible with little headspace on top.
- Volatile samples are taken in a VOA with no headspace. For there to be no headspace, the VOA should contain no bubbles. The VOA should be filled completely full.
- Please do not rinse the bottles before placing the sample in them. The bottles may contain some type of preservation.
- If uncertain of the type of sample container for a certain test, please refer to the other side.
- If you have any questions, about a sample please feel free to call and we can assist you.



Sample Packing and Shipping

- Place bubble wrap or some type of packing material on the bottom of the cooler.
- Make sure the caps of the container(s) are tightly screwed.
- Place the sample or samples in an upright position inside the cooler.
- Place packing material around the sample containers to keep them from hitting together.
- ❖ Samples must be stored at or below 4°C, except for PCB oil samples. Ice placed in a sealed plastic bag or cool packs should be placed in the cooler.
- Place the chain of custody in a sealed plastic bag and put it on top of ice.
- Close the lid of the cooler and make sure it is secure. Seal the cooler with shipping tape, making several revolutions around the cooler. It might also be a good idea to tape the drain to the cooler closed.
- Place the address of the destination and a return address. Now the cooler is ready to send.
